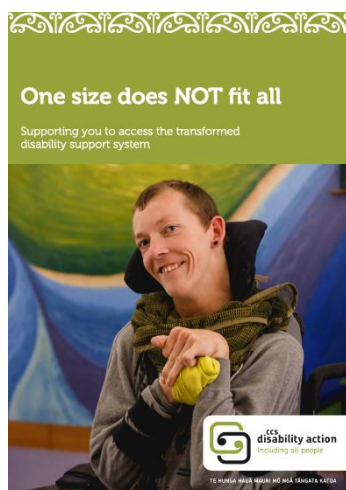

Mid Central includes people who live in:

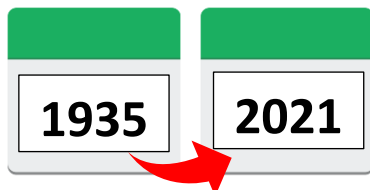
- Manawatū

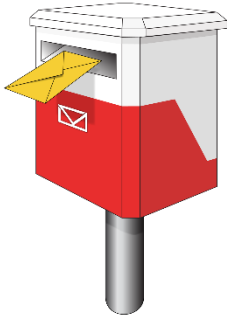
