We support almost 5 thousand disabled people and their families.



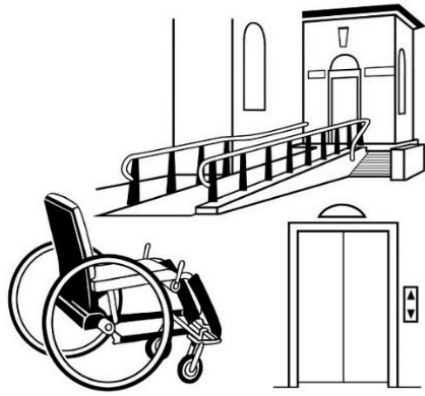
We can visit people who live in smaller communities.

We run the mobility parking scheme.

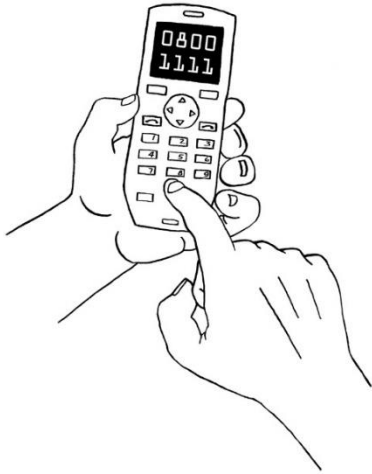
You can buy a permit so you can park in mobility parking spaces that are closer to buildings.



The money you pay for a permit can help us:

- make sure that mobility parks are used only by people with permits
- create more parking spaces if needed.

You can use the app to let us know if people are using mobility parking spaces without a permit.

You can download and save the app to your phone for free.



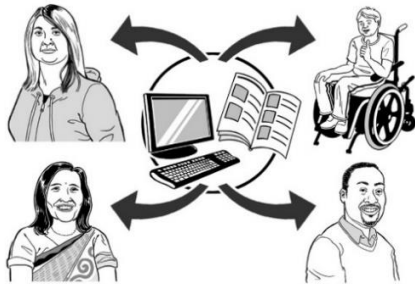

There are over 25 thousand **resources** that you can get from our library and information service.



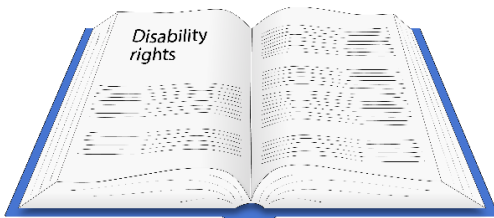
We have **resources** like:
