## What is Ministry of Health Intensive Wraparound service?

### Hei whakamārama i 'he awhina takitahi i ia tamaiti?'

**CCS DISABILITY ACTION'S** Ministry of Health Intensive Wraparound service involves creating flexible and tailored

supports for children and young people who require a high level of support. The aim is to give you the tools you need to suit the needs and aspirations of your family/whānau.

You can expect that these will encompass a range of community and home-based services specifically targeted at the needs of you and your child.

We are committed to delivering these in partnership with you. This means that we don't claim to be the expert in your family's or your child's needs. Instead we take a holistic approach, focusing on your child in the context of your whole family.

**Our team provide one-on-one support to work towards a life that has value for you and your family.**



E whakapono ana mātou me whai whānau ka tika te tamaiti, otirā, ngā hua katoa o te noho ā-whānau. Ko te aroha tēnā, te manaaki a ō rātou hapori. Nā rā, kia noho ki rō kāinga uruhau, i rō hapori aro nui.

Ko tā te ratonga 'He Awhina Takitahi I la Tamaiti' a CCS Disability Action he whakatū kaupapa tāngehe, motuhake mō te tamaiti, mō te taiohi rānei hei tautāwhi i a rātou e hiahia whai āwhina nui nei mō ō rātou hauātanga. Ko te wawata kia kāinga tautoko tō tamaiti, kia whai wāhi rānei e rite ana ki te kāinga. Ko te mea nui ko te waihanga kaupapa i runga i te āhua o ngā hiahia me ngā tūmanako o tō whānau.

We look at your family's needs and aspirations as a whole and work to create individualised supports to help you meet your goals.

Kāore he tepe mō te nui o te tautoko ka taea te tuku, i te kaha rerekē o ngā hiahia a tēnā me tēnā. Tērā tonu pea ngā ratonga ā-hapori, ā-kainga hoki ka whai wāhanga atu ki te hōtaka mō tō tamaiti, kei te āhua o ōu, me tāu tamaiti hiahia.

Ko te whāinga nui kia hangore, kia auaha hoki te kawenga o ēnei ratonga, ā, kia whai wāhi mai anō koe. Nāreira, e kore mātou e kīia ai he mātanga ki ngā hiahia o tō whānau, o tō tamaiti rānei. Heoi kē, ka whai aronga whānui mātou ki tō tamaiti me ōna āhua katoa, ā, ko te noho o tō tamaiti i roto anō i tō koutou whānau te aronga nui. E whakapono ana mātou, ki te mātai mātou i ngā āhuatanga o te whānau, ka tika tā mātou waihanga hōtaka mō koutou, mō ia rā.

Kei te whakapono mātou, ko tā 'He Awhina Takitahi I la Tamaiti' he whakarite i ngā tamariki me ō rātou whānau kia tōrunga ai ngā rā kei te heke, ā, kia tauawhitia tō tamaiti.



## How do you access our services? Ka pēhea ngā whānau e whiwhi āwhina ai?

**OUR MINISTRY OF Health** Intensive Wraparound service provides intensive individualised support for children and young people (between 5 – 21 years of age) with high support needs. It is fully funded by the Ministry of Health so there is no cost to you.

Your local Needs Assessment agency will determine your eligibility, so if you think you may need support, get in touch directly to discuss what is happening for your family.

Ko tā He Āwhina Takitahi I la Tamaiti he rato i ētahi tautoko rīrā nei, e aropū ana ki te motuhaketanga o tēnā tamaiti, o tēnā tamaiti, o tēnā taiohi, o tēnā taiohi (I waenga i ngā tau 5 – 21) e hia āwhina nui ana. He mea tautoko nā te Manatu Hauora, nāreira he ratonga kore-utu ki a koe.

Mā tō Tari Mātai Hauātanga e whakatau mēnā rānei e tika ana kia whai āwhina koe, nāreira ki te hiahia koe ki tēnei momo tautoko, tēnā whakapā mai ki a mātou ki te kōrero i ngā āhuatanga e pā ana ki tō whānau.



We put systems and supports in place so that you and your whānau can contribute from the outset – we call this our partnership approach.



## Negotiating the journey

### Te takahi i te huarahi

**WE UNDERSTAND** that charting a new path can feel like an additional hurdle to overcome, despite how promising the destination.

In order to build secure relationships and networks that you can rely on in the long-term, we will work with you in a number of stages. These are:

**Stage one:** putting in short-term supports to give you time and space to start planning.

**Stage two:** exploring long-term support options.

**Stage three:** providing a safety net as you take the lead.

E mārāma ana mātou tērā ngā māharahara ōu, ki hea ahu atu ai tō whānau. Kei pōhēhē he mahi uaua rawa te takahi huarahi hou, he taunahua e kore e ekea, ahakoa te hiahia nui kia eke panuku.

Ka tuku māu te āhua o tōna ao e whakatau, mā te whakatū hononga tenatena, hononga e kore e motukia hei toko i a koe hei te roanga ake o te wā. E mōhio pū ana mātou e kore tēnei e oti i te pō kotahi, nāreira ko te whakawhanaunga atu ki a koe me tāu tamaiti te mahi, ā, mā tātou tahi tētahi korowai manaaki e whatu, ā, ā tōna wā ka oti.

**Taumata tuatahi:** He whāriki i ngā paetata, me ētahi tautāwhitanga.

**Taumata tuarua:** te whāwhā ake i ētahi ara whai āwhina anō, hei painga a muri ake.

**Taumata tuatoru:** Mā mātou koe e tautoko, ka riro ana i a koe te aratakitanga o te hōtaka manaaki i tāu tamaiti.



## Your team

### Te kapa tautoko i tō whānau

**YOUR CHILD'S TEAM** will have a Support Coordinator who will work with you and any relevant agencies to create supports that work for you.

It may also include some other members, depending on a young person's needs, such as:

- Advisor on deaf children
- Behaviour support
- Community support worker
- Foster carer or shared care family
- Occupational therapist
- Psychologist
- Physiotherapist
- Resource teacher vision
- Speech-language therapist

You remain your child's strongest advocate and have the right to decide who is on your family/whānau's team.

Ka tohua ki tō kapa tētahi Pou Taunaki Hapori, mā tō whānau e tautoko. Ka mahi ngātahi ia me ngā tari hei hanga hōtaka tautoko mōu.

Ā, kei te āhua o tō tamaiti, anei pea ētahi atu ringa tautoko mō tō kapa:

- Hei mātanga tamariki turi hei tohutohu
- He tautāwhitanga whanonga
- He kaimahi taunaki ā-hapori
- He kaikumanu he whānau hoa kūmanu rānei
- He kaihaumanu pūkenga taketake
- He kaimātai hinengaro
- He kairomiromi
- He kaiako rauemi kite
- He kaiwhakatika reo kōrero

Ka noho ko koe hei kaitaunaki matua mō tō tamaiti, ā, e kore rawa mātou e whakahē i āu e whakatau ai mō te kapa tautoko i tō whānau.
